Full-Time Students

WHEN: Once a week for 1 ½ hours

CLASS DAYS: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday. All other days by special arrangement.

CLASS TIMES: 3:30 – 5:00, 5:00 – 6:30; 4:00 – 5:30, 5:30 – 7:00. Combination varies from year to year.

ADULT CLASSES: Morning, Early Afternoon, and Evenings by special arrangement.

REGISTRATION: \$140 non-refundable ANNUAL fee. Due July 1; discounted for continuing students.

COST: \$85 per month. Payment is due on the 15th of each month -- for the upcoming month's lessons. A \$25 late fee is charged on payments made after the 20th -- unless prior payment arrangements are made.

SUPPLIES: \$40 ANNUAL fee covers general supplies provided by the studio including: drawing paper, pencils, 80 lb. linen, cover stock, Bristol board, newsprint, colored paper of many types, watercolor paper, brushes, oil paint, acrylics, watercolor, prismacolor pencils, pastels, craft sticks, warm glue, glitter, and much more. Students must supply their own canvas board and stretched canvas, and those who wish to do projects requiring special materials must also provide those as needed.

Part-Time Students

WHEN: Summer and Holiday Workshops, and by request during full time classes as space allows.

CLASS DAYS/TIMES: Schedule varies from year to year.

REGISTRATION: \$25 non-refundable ANNUAL fee.

COST: \$85 for each set of three classes, paid in advance.

SUPPLIES: \$20 ANNUAL supply fee covers supplies provided by the studio including all those listed above. Students must supply their own canvas board and stretched canvas as well as materials needed for special projects.
